In the time of the Roman Empire, the term bondservant or slave could refer to someone who voluntarily served others. But it usually referred to one who was held in a permanent position of servitude. Under Roman law, a bondservant was considered the owner's personal property. Slaves essentially had no rights and could even be killed with impunity by their owners. See: Romans 1:1; Galatians 1:10; Philippians 2:7; Colossians 4:12; Titus 1:1; James 1:1; 2 Peter 1:1; Jude 1.
